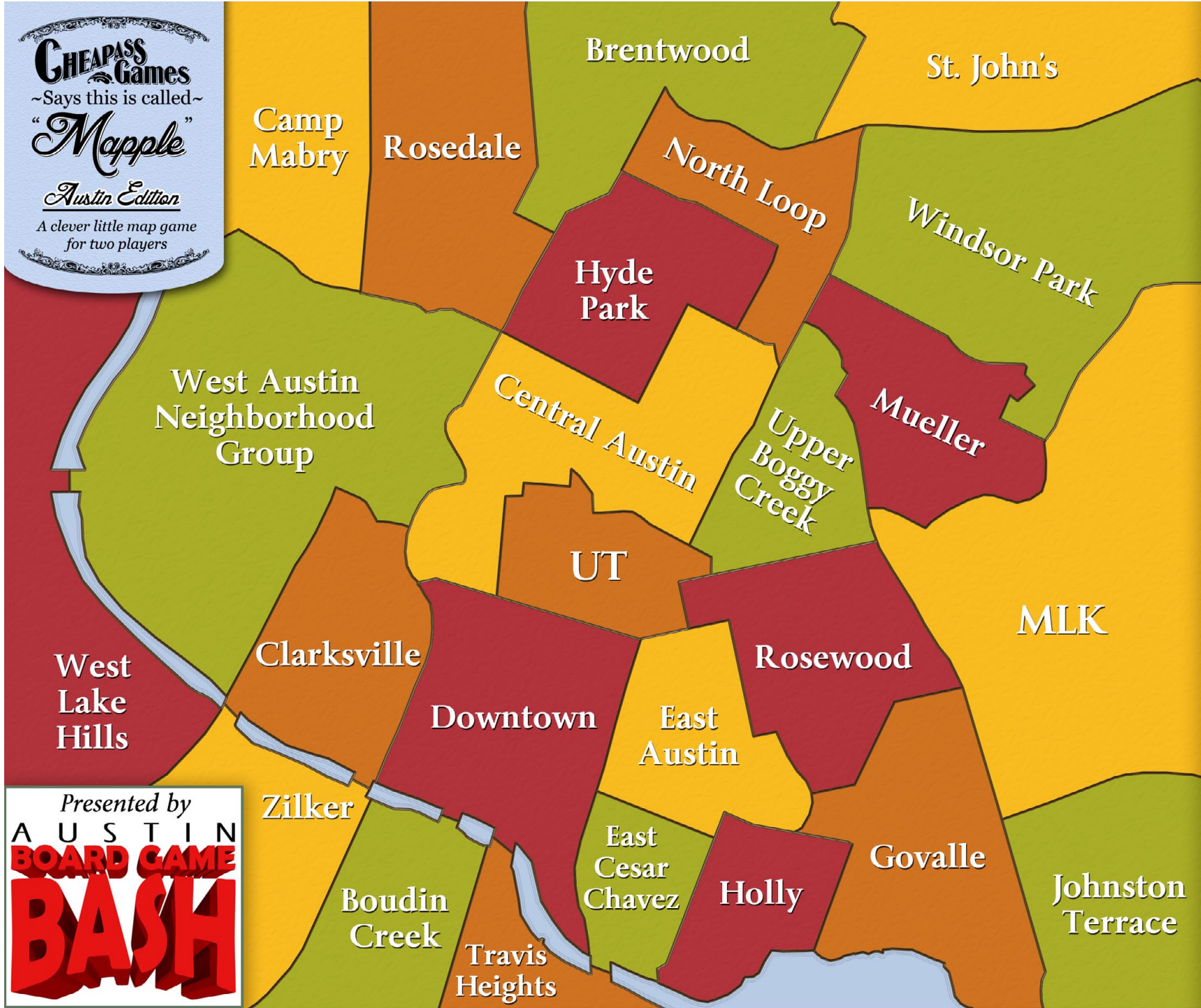

**Rules:** Each player uses ten coins: One quarter, two dimes, three nickels, and four pennies. One player is "heads" and the other is "tails." Players take turns placing coins in empty areas. When you play a coin, it flips over enemy coins in neighboring areas, if those coins are of lesser value. Areas that touch only on the diagonal are not considered connected.
